## HOW TO TAKE PREP

There are different ways to take PrEP

- Daily: Taking one pill every day for lasting protection
- On-demand: Taking PrEP pills only when you are at risk for getting HIV

## FIRST TIME USING PREP?

- PrEP is safe for most people.
- Some people may feel nausea, headache, diarrhoea, bloating or tiredness when they first start, but this usually improves when a few days or weeks.
- Speak to your doctor, nurse or pharmacist if side effects are severe or do not improve.

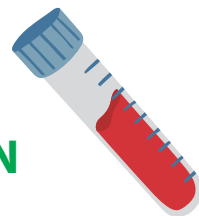
